Required Training Certification
 (Offered at Sullivan County BOCES)

Bloodborne Pathogens – 1hr.

The New York State Department of Education requires all employees to attend a mandatory (1hr.) certification training on Bloodborne Pathogens. This training includes information on HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis A, B&C, and other blood related pathogens. OSHA Regulation 29 CFR Part 1910.1030, Occupational Exposure to Bloodborne Pathogens, in conjunction with the State's PESH regulation, requires that schools develop, implement and evaluate a Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure Control Plan which includes a comprehensive training program.

HAZCOM/Right to Know - 1hr.

OSHA Regulation 29 CFR Part 1910.1200, Occupational Exposure to Hazardous Chemicals, in conjunction with the State's PESH regulations, requires that schools develop, implement and evaluate an Chemical Exposure Control Plan. Part of this plan includes mandatory in-depth training on chemical safety for all new employees. Topics covered include Chemical Inventory, Material Safety Data Sheets, Required Protection, and Recordkeeping. This training is mandatory for anyone who has not previously had a full (1 hour) Right to Know training.

Note - All new employees are required to attend both of these initial certification classes. All employees returning for the following school year that have obtained an initial BBP/RTK certificate, are required to attend the refresher re-certification courses provided by BOCES, or the districts at least once each school year.
